Red Bag: Teen Challenge

Teen Challenge Canada operates 12-month faith-based in-residence alcohol and drug addiction rehabilitation programs for adults 18+. The programs first began in the 1960's in Toronto and have since expanded with centers located in Alberta, Atlantic Canada, Saskatchewan and other areas of Ontario. World-wide there are more than 1,400 locations. They offer help and hope to those struggling with alcoholism and/or addiction to other drugs. Clients learn character and leadership development skills, health and life skills, and have the

opportunity to acquire some vocational training. Their mission is to demonstrate God's love by helping individuals become free from substance addiction and equipping them to

live full and meaningful lives.
